## Uniforms & Dress Code Reminders



- **Tops:** Any uniform item which requires a logo must be embroidered, no other decoration type is permitted (i.e. screen print, vinyl, etc.).
- **Shoes:** Solid brown, black, or navy loafers, flats, boat shoes, or sneakers. No open toe shoes, heels higher than 1/2 inch, or boots.
- **Outerwear:** Only the following outerwear items are permitted to be worn inside the school building. Outerwear worn inside must be unzipped and students are required to wear an SCA uniform shirt underneath.
  - Solid navy or red cardigan (zipper or button closure) with SCA's embroidered logo
  - Solid navy or red full zip fleece jacket with SCA's embroidered logo
  - Solid navy or red pullover v-neck sweater/sweater vest with SCA's embroidered logo
- **Hairstyles:** Hair color must be a naturally occurring color. Hair accessories can only be navy, red, white, or SCA's plaid.
- **Physical Education (PE) Uniform:** Upper school students are required to change out of their school uniform attire into SCA's physical education uniform. Kindergarten through 3rd grade students will not change out for their PE classes but 4th and 5th grade students will be given the option to change out but will not be required. PE uniforms can be purchased during Open House for \$25; each set comes with t-shirt, shorts, and drawstring bag.

## Electronic Devices

Personal electronic devices are not permitted for use during the instructional day (7:00am-3:45pm).

Type of devices includes:

- Cellphones
- Tablets
- Earbuds/Airpods
- Personal Laptops
- Smartwatches
- Smart Glasses

Any technology required for use during the school day will be provided by instructional staff.



## Attendance

Regular attendance is important for student achievement and growth. Students who are chronically absent, tardy, or leave school early miss valuable learning opportunities. They have more difficulty completing their assignments, preparing for class, understanding the content taught, and improving their overall proficiency which is needed for advancement to the next grade level. **Excessive absences, tardies, and/or early releases violate SCA's Code of Conduct and have negative implications on students' potential promotion and continued enrollment.**



## Carline

In order for children to be picked-up during carline, drivers must have the SCA placard displayed at all times including the first day of school. Children will not be released without a placard present; pictures will not suffice. Families are provided with two placards and two keychain tags which can be shared amongst drivers who are picking up students. **On Friday, July 28th families can pick-up carline placards during Open House times.** Placards that are not picked-up will be sent home with students on the first day of school - please note this option will not allow students to be released during afternoon carline and means they will have to be signed out through the main office at 3:45pm, once carline has ended.
